children). There will be pizza, drinks and a licensed bar. Buy your tickets early to avoid disappointment.

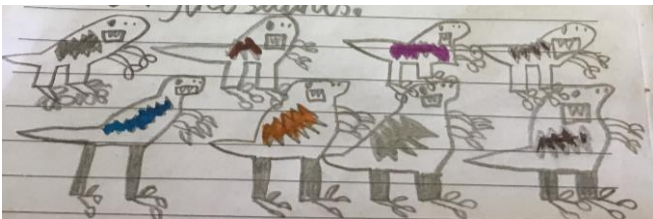
CLASS OF THE WEEK
