



GREEN highlighter	Well done! There is good work here. Success Criteria evident or Learning Intention met.
PINK highlighter	Think. What is missing or could be improved here?
PURPLE pen	All teacher comments are in purple pen.
RED pen	Red pen is used by pupils to show when they have edited, improved or corrected their work, often in response to marking.
GREEN pen	Green pen is used when peer-marking has been done. (Pupil who has made comments and suggestions in green to also write their name).
I	Denotes independent work.
S	Denotes work with some adult support.
1:1	Denotes work has been done with individual adult help.
V	Verbal feedback has been given.
W	A wish. (Next time this work could be improved by doing this).
✓	One , two or three ticks-usually in pencil- beside the Learning Intention can be used by older pupils to show the extent to which they feel they have succeeded. (If these ticks are in purple, it is the teacher's comment on the pupil's success).
