GOVERNING BODY (SEPT 2017)

General

The Governors of Bishop Tachbrook C E Primary School wish you a warm welcome to the school. Our Governing Body (GB) is made up of 11 Governor Posts, as set out within the Instrument of Government Voluntary Controlled Schools dated 14th December 2014 which came into effect on 1st January 2015:

- 1 x Head Teacher/voter
- 2 x Foundation Governors
- 1 x Local Authority Governor
- 1 x Staff Governor
- 2 x Parent Governors
- 4 x Co-opted Governors

According to the DfE's (Department of Education) Governance Handbook, the GB has a number of core functions:

- Setting vision, ethos and strategic direction of the school.
- Holding the Head teacher to account
- Overseeing financial performance
- Looking at objective data about school's performance

To undertake these functions, in addition to the Full Governing Body meetings, we also have 3 other committees – Resources Committee, Pupil Performance and Standards Committee and Pay Committee. The Full Governing Body and the Resources and Pupil Performance and Standards Committees meet once a term at least. The Pay Committee meets once a year.

In addition to the above table the following roles and responsibilities also apply:

Grievance/Disciplinary/Complaints Hearings

Any Three Governors who haven't been involved in the matter before hearing

Appeals Hearing

Any Three Governors who haven't been involved in original hearing or the matter before.

Exclusions

Any Three Governors excluding Staff Governor and Parent Governors.
