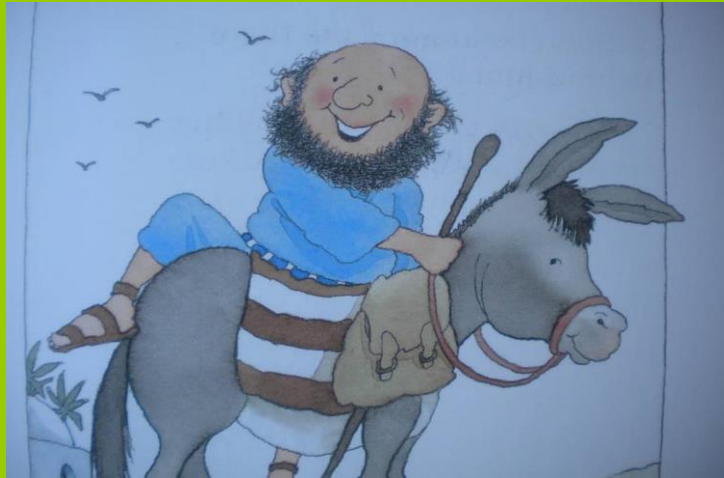


A Governor listened to The Good Samaritan story and how our school's Christian values teach children to 'love your neighbour as yourself'.
