



## Times Tables

Dear Parents,

Times tables are related to many areas of Numeracy and the ability to recall facts quickly and accurately will help your child's progress. Even if your child knows their tables, regular practice is important as they are easily forgotten. Short but regular bursts of practice are best.

Below are some ways in which you can support your child's progress at home.

- Chanting tables aloud (forwards and back).
- Quick fire questions (in any order).
- Written quiz.
- Write them out (make a poster and display them in a room where they will be seen often).
- Say the answer and your child can give you the question.
- Write the questions and answers out on small pieces of paper and play a pairing/matching game.
- Use a deck of playing cards. (Each player puts a card down, multiply the two cards, winner keeps the cards).

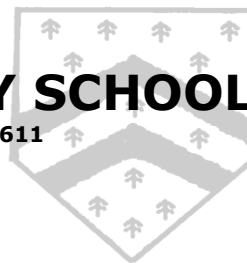

4	2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and corresponding division facts.
5	Quick recall of multiplication and division facts for all tables.
6	Quick recall of multiplication and division facts for all tables.
