Dear Parents and Carers of Years 3 and 4

Visit to Coventry Herbert Museum and Coventry Transport Museum

On Tuesday, 18th June Year 3 and Year 4 will be visiting The Herbert Museum to learn about Coventry during World War II and The Transport Museum to take part in the Blackout, Rationing and Evacuee session as part of our local history topic on WWII.

The cost of the trip is £5.80 per child to include entry fees, the activities led by museum staff and the coach. We have applied for a bursary towards the cost of the coach which has enabled us to charge a much reduced rate for this trip. We are very hopeful that the bursary will be approved but in the event of it not being we will have to charge an additional amount to cover any shortfall. In conforming with the Governors' Policy on Charges for School Activities we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £5.80 to cover the cost. We hope you will be able to make a donation although no child will be excluded if he/she is unable to make a contribution. However, the school reserves the right to cancel the activity if money is insufficient to cover costs. Please could you send this money by **Monday 10th June.**

The coach will leave school at 9.15am, therefore please could you ensure your child arrives promptly on this day, and will return for the end of school.

The children must:

- wear school uniform and school shoes (no sandals).
- apply sun cream before coming to school if the forecast is for sunny weather.
- bring a waterproof coat and/or a sun hat depending on the weather
- have a packed lunch with a drink (non fizzy) in a small backpack.

No lunch boxes or flasks please as everything will be thrown away after lunch.

Please note school packed lunches can only be provided if your child is entitled to a free school meal but these must be booked through the school office **by Monday 10th June at the very latest.**
